



Community Earth System Modeling Tutorial 12-16 July 2010

The Community Earth System Model (CESM) project at the National Center for Atmospheric Research (NCAR) will coordinate a primer on climate modeling 12 – 16 July 2010 in Boulder, Colorado. The focus will be on modeling of the coupled climate system and its major components.

The tutorial is targeted at graduate students who wish to learn how to understand, run, and modify climate models for scientific applications. The focus will be on CESM specifically. Specific content will be tailored to meet students' needs.

The tutorial will last 5 days and include:

- (a) Lectures on climate modeling, focusing on techniques and approaches in CESM
- (b) Practical sessions on running and modifying the components of CESM

Because space will be limited to 40 students, we are asking for a brief on-line application to balance attendees across institutions and for distributing any potential funding.
